Mr. Morgan noted that the custodial team will be working on the grounds in the next week to have facilities in tip top shape for Graduation.

Mr. Targgart and Dr. Younghans both noted that today was Field Day for their last student day and both are happy to have open positions filled early on. They are both working on closing out the year and compiling class lists.

Mrs. Vice noted that they held graduation practice and afterwards took a walk through the Elementary Field Day, which they really enjoyed. She also noted that summer school begins Wednesday.

Mr. Osenbaugh reiterated the facilities and grounds plan for graduation and also gave a brief update on the outstanding grants accounts and his reconciliation efforts.

Mrs. Young noted that bus inspection was May 10<sup>th</sup> and thanks to Luke's diligent efforts, passed with 100%. She also noted that we have 1 bus driver retiring this year and 2 new buses will be delivered sometime in June.

Mrs. Howard updated the board on grants received in the last month. She noted \$10,000 for 2 technical educators, \$8,000 from Bosch to outfit the daycare with toys, \$5,000 in matching funds for school to home supports efforts and an additional \$500 from Walmart for marketing.

With no further business or comments, the meeting was adjourned at 5:14 p.m. followed by the signing of documents.
